- •Church Use Guideline updates Effective starting May 1, 2024
- •The council has updated our Church Use policy and included a hard copy in your mailbox and an electronic copy for you to look over. The main changes are:
- •\$100 damage deposit is required for all activities (member and nonmembers, due 2 weeks prior to your event to hold your spot. Refunds are fully refundable if facility is left clean.)
- Non-church related activities are now a \$25 fee (family gatherings, meetings, team meals, etc...)
- Non-profit groups may use the facility free of charge but must have damage deposit
- •There may be a \$25 custodial fee added to any event if additional help is needed.
